Safe School Bus Riding - AAA

1 Arrive at the bus stop a few minutes early That way you don't have to rush and the bus stays on schedule 2 Wait for your bus in a safe place — well off the roadway 3 Do not move toward the bus until it has come to a complete stop 4 Enter the bus in an orderly manner, single file, and use the handrail 5 Always follow the instructions of your school bus
